



Phase One (Beginning May 31):

- Worship outdoors at Northside Harvest Park
- Each person/family brings lawn chairs or blankets for seating and maintains social distancing by family
- Kids will remain with family for duration of the service; activity sheets and kid appropriate teaching will be offered during service
- No contact passing of peace
- Livestreaming will continue to be offered through Zoom
- Communion in one kind will be served (bread only, precut)
- Masks, and hand sanitizer will be available
- Morning Prayer on Zoom Monday-Friday
- Offering collected online and deposited in basket when coming for Communion
- Parents are encouraged to bring snacks and water for their kids

Phase Two (pending two consecutive weeks of infection rate declines):

Assuming CDC recommended gating criteria for phase two met regionally.

- Return to church building with chairs removed and repositioned to allow for family social distancing
- Completely sanitize worship space before and after service
- Kids remain with family; activity sheets and kid appropriate teaching will be offered during service
- No contact passing of peace
- Livestreaming available on Zoom
- Communion in one kind will be served (bread only, precut)
- Masks, thermometer, hand sanitizer, and gloves will be available
- Masks required during service
- Offering collected online and deposited in basket when coming for Communion

Phase Three:

Assuming CDC recommended gating criteria for phase three met regionally.

- Return to seating capacity
- Kids ministry resumes during service
- No contact passing of peace
- Communion in both kinds served with celebrant dipping bread in wine
- Hand sanitizer available throughout building
- Offering collected online and deposited in basket when coming for Communion
